Emma is on the case!!

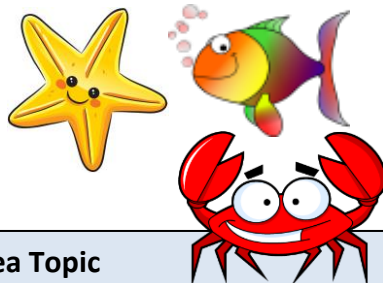
Reminder
